Activity: Jefferson Land Trust Spring Break Youth Corps

WELCOME TO YOUTH CORPS!

Description: Youth Corps is a field-based internship. The corps member will work as part of a team of 16-18 year old high school students to complete a variety of tasks necessary to maintain or restore our local natural lands to their best possible condition. The work will be entirely outdoors and will be physically demanding – visiting some of the most remote places and difficult terrain that Jefferson Land Trust protects and stewards for water quality and habitat. With each new task, corps members will learn the importance of the management activity to forest and stream health. Examples of tasks include: blackberry thicket removal, survey across steep, uneven terrain, trash removal from creek corridor, in-creek removal of nightshade that can block fish passage, and habitat restoration.

Expectations: We will provide real-world training in natural land management and connect youth with local Preserves that protect important water quality, plant, and wildlife habitat for many generations to come. We expect corps members to:

- 1) Abide by safety rules
- 2) Participate fully in the internship by arriving on time, ready and interested to learn and undertake tasks at hand
- 3) Come prepared with personal water and gear (see below)

Gear: Available to borrow upon request - let us know by March 28

Rubber boots and work boots/sturdy footwear

Rain jacket

Rain pants

Personal water bottle

Any personal medications necessary (provided by parent/guardian)

Light lunch provided - bring personal snacks as necessary

Stipend: A \$250 stipend will be provided for participation in this week-long internship.
